REPORT FROM HONDURAS

What God is doing in Honduras!

"Has God not chosen the poor of this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom which He promised to those that love Him? James 2:5

The evangelical church in Honduras is indeed rich in faith. They have a great love for Israel, having weekly prayer times praying for the peace of Jerusalem and displaying Israeli flags at the pulpits in many, many churches.

Believers were deeply interested in the talks we gave on Israel, the prophecies in Ezekiel 36-39, and Joel's book Epicenter. Groups of young people gathered around us after our talks wanting to hear more and ask questions.



God's timing had us giving these talks in the same week that Benjamin Netanyahu was in Washington DC--- receiving a cold reception from the White House. Again world events were lining up with the prophecies in Ezekiel!

The Holy Spirit has awakened much of the Central American Church to understand the times we are living in.

For example, one day we drove to Comayagua, the oldest city in all Central America established in 1537. Comayagua is being physically restored. On a short ride around the town, we noticed workmen on ladders repainting the ancient Spanish colonial buildings in vibrant colors of yellow, ochre, and russet. Comayagua has great charm. A group of school children were in costume, ready to do a musical performance in the municipal building on the old town square.

All the time I wondered if we were in a real place or on a Hollywood set.

I, Mary, talked with about 25 pastors about Epicenter. These pastors think that God has chosen their city to be the spiritual epicenter of Central America. They also were deeply interested in the events in Israel.

Other encouraging blessings

- * A believer in Miami had given an English copy of Epicenter to the man who was to be our translator. So we had a good connection and he was happy to translate what he was so interested in.

- * We gave a copy of Epicentro to a visiting pastor from Costa Rica.

- * The live TV show we were on is seen in the four northern states of Honduras, the Bay Islands, and Belize. The one hour interview and call-in questions were insightful: e.g. Is Israel a clock for the end-time events?

* We traveled with Professionals to the World. John and Charly Potts and Jim and Barb Hermanson take North American professionals to universities in Honduras to give lectures on their particular disciplines. After the lectures, Honduran young people from the church Ministerio Renuevo give the gospel and an opportunity to pray to receive Christ.

Len's architectural talks ("*World View for Architects*" and "*Best Practices for Young Architects and Engineers*") were attended by 260 university students and professors. Len spoke from his personal architectural experiences and told his story of repentance and salvation. After one of the talks, twelve students prayed to receive Christ. Several others said they wanted a follow-up Bible study.

* These same young folks who give the gospel presentations visit the hospital in San Pedro Sula twice a day and we went with them. Our visits to the hospital were precious - visiting 200 kids per visit, handing out snacks and praying for the families.



* The Lord had me praying in Spanish by the third day of the trip. Praying in their language was a great ministry to these hurting parents and grandparents of the little patients.

I (Mary) have never studied Spanish so I give the credit all to Jesus. I did memorize two Bible verses the first morning: Psalm 26:14 and 2 Corinthians 1:3 which I could offer in Spanish as an encouragement.

* We did need to endure hardship as a good soldier. Len was bitten by a "jejen" which is like a mosquito but more virulent. His toe is still swollen, red, and painful -- more than a week later.

We're looking forward to how God will use the books and our teaching.
